INGENES PRIVACY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to describe how INSTITUTO DE INFERTILIDAD Y GENÉTICA MÉXICO SC, d/b/a INGENES ("INGENES") collects, uses and shares information about you through online interfaces and properties, including the https://www.us.ingenes.com website (the "Site"), as well as the services ("Services") and products ("Products") available to users through the Site and landing pages. INTITUTO DE INFERTILIDAD Y GENÉTICA MÉXICO SC ("INGENES", "we," "us," and "our") contracts with THE P.C's¹, regarding online telehealth medical consultations and secure messaging between physicians (individually the "Provider" and collectively the "Providers") and patients. The professional medical services (which are provided by THE P.C's) and the non-clinical Site services (which are provided by INGENES) are collectively referred to in this Terms of Use as the "Services". INFORMATION THAT WE COLLECT

Information You Provide to Us. We collect information you provide to us, for instance, when you create or modify your account, register to use our Site, purchase products or services from us, request information from us or otherwise communicate with us. This information may include:

- Full Name
- Home address
- Telephone number and your partner telephone number
- Payment information (credit card or debit card number, expiration date and credit card security code solely for payment purposes)
- If billing is required, the fiscal data necessary for issuing the invoice, in terms of the current tax legislation.
- Username and password
- Demographic/health/wellness data (such as your gender, marital status, age, wellness background, weight, height, lifestyle information, medication history, zip code)
